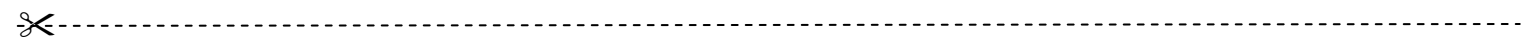

# GTZ Matters...

## GET THE GTZ VISION!!

Grace, Trinity & Zion members ... Over the past few months, the Parish Advisory Council (PAC) has been holding information sessions to update you on the GTZ Vision. Here is a summary of what has happened over the last year, and the plans for the next couple months:

### What Has Been Happening?

In spring of 2010, the GTZ Parish was formed with a mission of **“Reaching Out Together In Faith, Hope and Love”**. A “Vision Team” consisting of two members from each congregation worked very hard over the last year to determine a vision for the parish. The team has completed their work, and the Parish Advisory Council has approved **“Vision 2016”**.

Informational sessions about **“Vision2016”** occurred on June 19<sup>th</sup>, July 14<sup>th</sup>, and July 31<sup>st</sup>. Hopefully you have been able to attend one of the sessions and have had the opportunity to learn about the great plans for the GTZ Parish!

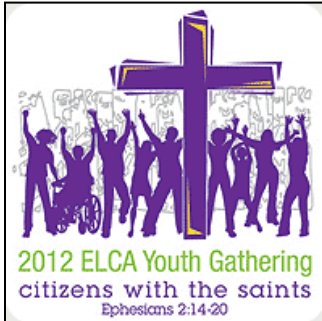

## ELCA YOUTH GATHERING July 18-22, 2012

After Hurricane Katrina slammed into the Gulf Coast, wreaking havoc on the city of New Orleans, ELCA members rolled up their sleeves and helped with the heavy lifting. In 2009, 37,000 ELCA young people showed up in New Orleans ready to help rebuild a struggling city. Sure, they completed service projects - they painted, took out trash, raked, cleaned, and made repairs, because there was a lot of physical work to be done. But they also made a human connection. They learned about hospitality and how people overcame anxiety with an unwavering faith. They began a journey that travels far beyond service projects with the residents of NOLA. That's why the ELCA Youth Gathering is going back to New Orleans in 2012 to continue the good work and learn about the new house God is building "a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling place for God." Ephesians 2:21b-22

- Children learn that church/Sunday school/ worship/etc. are safe places for them to share, build relationships, express their faith and welcome other children
- It takes a child to make a congregation.

### **Let's Paint!**

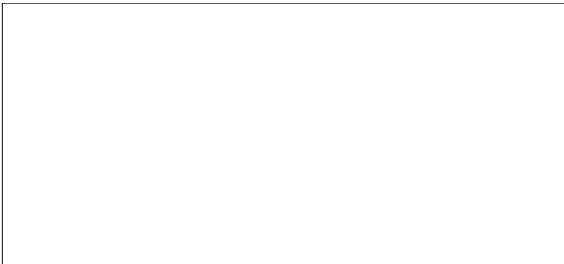
