**TRINITY COUNCIL MINUTES FROM DECEMBER 15, 2009**

**Attendance:** Pastor Mary Beth Kovanen, Pastor Kurt Kovanen, Tom Scheuerman, Kathy Kuck, Terry Howe, Jeff Dorow, David Ott, Jean Haese, Marilyn Schucknecht, Jann Seidl

**Secretary's Report** – The minutes of the November 17, 2009 meeting were reviewed and approved.

**Treasurer's Report** – The council was pleased that Trinity's "net loss" each month has slowed recently, however the year-to-date loss remains quite significant.

**Property Report** - The committee reported on some recent water damage that will need to be addressed. Further inspection and cost estimates are in the process.

**Warming Shelter** - Kathy Kuck reported that the Fox Valley Warming Shelter plans are going well. Volunteers are still needed to fill certain shifts. Meals are fairly well covered. They look to serve 12-20 guests each night. The Emergency Shelter currently has some openings so the warming shelter may not be as full as in years past.

**GTZ Strategic Planning Team** – David Ott reported that there will be a large group council meeting Monday, December 21, at Grace Lutheran to discuss a partnership proposal of the GTZ Partnership Churches (Grace, Trinity and Zion Lutheran). Congregation Council members from all three congregations are invited and are encouraged to attend. The proposal will be shared with the councils and discussed.

**Nominating Committee** – Nominees for Church council are as follows: Jeff Dorow and Jean Haese will continue through 2010, Jann Seidl through 2011. Nominees for 2010 for a one year term are David Ott, Tom Scheuerman, and Marilyn Schucknecht. Ruth Marquardt is nominated for a three year term (2012). As always, nominations remain open until the annual meeting.

**Women's Brunch** - This event was very successful. \$784.00 was raised through the basket auction and approximately \$1,000.00 will be donated (with the help of Thrivent) to Harbor House. The hall was filled with 35 beautifully decorated tables seating 8. Michael's catered the delicious brunch. The church was filled with women listening to the entertaining Mary Pierce (The Laugh Lady). The council wishes to thank everyone who made this event possible. There were very few glitches. Unforeseen parking issues, the need for more coat racks and signs for the facilities would help make this event run even smoother if it were done again.

**Annual Meeting** - Plans will need to be made for the annual meeting Jan 31. The proposal from the SPT will be delivered by power point, thereafter breakout into small groups after to discuss and develop questions. It will be a potluck dinner.

**January Council Meeting** – Council will meet on Jan. 12, 2010 to finalize budget and plans for the Annual Meeting.

**Hmong Drop-in Center** - Pastor Kurt reports that Lutheran Social Services is looking for another site for the Hmong elderly to come for socialization on Tuesdays from 9 am to noon. Pastor is waiting for a written proposal.

**Dedicated Funds** – The council approved a request from a donor that the unused portion of monies dedicated to the purchase of hymnbooks be re-directed towards youth activities.

**Oneida Street Sign** - The sign will need to be changed to reflect the Christmas service schedule.

**Urban Threads** - Urban Threads will now be housed in the basement of the City Center. There will be utility fees that will need to be paid. Downtown ELCA churches may want to consider paying this cost.

## A WORD FROM BISHOP JUSTMAN

Have you noticed that folks are asking many questions these days? Questions are good. I'm all for asking questions and searching for meaningful responses.

One question that is not being asked enough is this:

*"What does it mean for us to be church together?"*

Let's start with some definitions. The word for 'church' in the New Testament is 'ecclesia.' It means: "The called out or sent ones." We are called and sent with the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Dietrich Bonhoeffer asserts: *"Christianity means community through Jesus Christ and in Jesus Christ, No Christian community is more or less than this... We belong to one another only through and in Jesus Christ."* (Life Together, Bonhoeffer, p.21)

Webster's dictionary defines 'together' as: *"in a body as a group."*

That's great! The Bible is loaded with rich imagery about being the 'body of Christ' as we seek to be the church together. Look at the 12th chapter of 1 Corinthians where Paul writes: *"For just as the body is one and has many members, and all members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ."* (1 Cor. 12:12)

So, if we are called and sent as a body to proclaim the name of Jesus Christ we can begin to consider how we shall respond to the question: *"What does it mean for us to be church together?"* Can we be bold enough to move forward with Christ at the center of all we do?

~If we decide to build or not to build, it should be as a body seeking to proclaim the saving grace of Jesus Christ.

~If we decide to leave or not to leave, it should be as a body seeking to honor the life, death and resurrection of our Risen Lord.

~If we decide to change our worship styles or patterns, it should be done as a body seeking to spread the good news of Jesus Christ to both friends and strangers so that all are welcomed.

It is an important time for us to be church together. The world is watching. The world expects us to fracture, split, argue and go our separate ways. I'd like for us to surprise the world by standing together in this difficult time to say:

*We are diverse. We have many ideas and concerns. We are imperfect, sometimes stubborn, often wrong and sinners all. Still, because of Jesus Christ, we are claimed and freed. Because of Jesus Christ and the power of God's Holy Spirit we shake off our sins, stand together and dare to minister to the needs of the world as the body of Christ. For:*

*"We are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us.  
(2 Corinthians 5:20)*

**FOUNDATION GRANTS AVAILABLE**

The Trinity Foundation Grants Committee will meet soon to consider grant requests. Remember the Foundation exists to provide resources for special projects or programs.

1. Which would seem likely to enrich or provide some special benefit to the spiritual life of the congregation;
2. Which would provide some worthy addition or improvement to the congregation's facilities, not likely of achievement through other channels;
3. Which would give needed assistance or support to a worthy individual or family or worthy Christian enterprise or program.

Any grant requests need to be submitted to the church office no later than **January 15th**. Request forms are available in the church office.

**\$5,000 Matching Grant Received**

Thrivent Financial offered a one time grant to organizations that needed extra help as other funding sources decreased.

A collaboration of Trinity Lutheran, Fox Valley Lutheran Homes and Loaves & Fishes applied for the grant to continue and expand the Community Meal that Loaves and Fishes has held at Trinity for 10 years. Fox Valley Lutheran Homes recently joined this ministry with nurses to offer blood pressures, consultations, referrals and hygiene kits.

The free Community Meal is Monday evening and open to all. Prior to this year, 40-50 attended and has now grown to 100-125 as the need continues to grow. Attending this meal are those trying to make ends meet including; elders, disabled, struggling families with children, unemployed and homeless. This is the only free evening meal we know of. This grant will help continue and expand to two evenings a week. The meal is prepared and served by volunteers from many churches in the Valley.

In addition to the base of \$5,000, Thrivent will match additional contributions up to \$10,000. 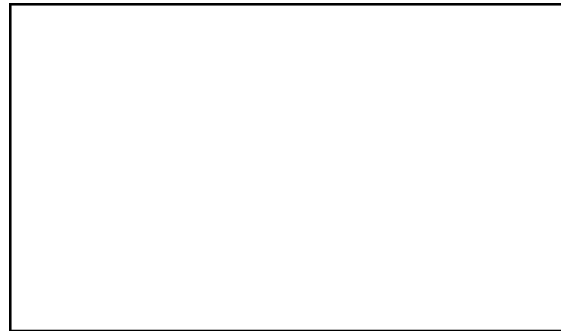
