Lent: Time for "Soul" Care

Lent is the season of the church year when people are invited to be disciples and prepare for Easter by taking care of the soul. The image for Lent is not punishment, but promises of "solace," of "salve,"...of salvation. It is the season which prepares us for joy. Lent teaches us what being forgiven and made whole means. Repentance may tear down what is weak and twisted, but it also builds up that which is of God.

To help us remember that Lent is a joyful journey into the heart of God, the church has traditionally practiced three disciplines Jesus speaks about (see Matthew 6):

Prayer—the formation of our heart and mind

Fasting—the formation of our body

Charity—the formation of community

We, like Christians of all ages, keep these Lenten disciplines in order to "refocus on God." In the routine of our day to day life, we can easily become distracted and lose our Christ-centered focus. The Lenten disciplines help God's people to remember that all life springs from God!

FEBRUARY 22, 2009 SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**I. President David Otts called the meeting to order.**

The purpose of the meeting to present, discuss and pass the 2009 budget.

The strategic principles guiding the process are to:

1. Minimize the deficit to create a 3-year window to enable strategy options
2. Not to eliminate staff, and to manage resource costs through attrition
3. Shift mission/outreach to individual contributions, and special fundraisers - targeting budget funds to provide for overhead expenses
4. Strive to keep other ministry programs to actual 2008 spending levels.

II. Discussion

- The weekly income has remained flat and continues to be "faith-based". David will continue to look into ways to raise income.
- Regarding HR, Elmer is leaving and we are looking at not filling his position, but will try other ways to maintain Trinity. All staff salaries are frozen.
- Office expenses to be cut, currently exploring alternative ways for mailings. Our current service contracts must be maintained.
- Mission/outreach will be reduced to zero as we are unable to support our own current deficits. (Sharon Helms noted that we have probably already have given to Outreach for January and February of this year.)
- With the budget we will be running the year with a deficit of \$20,500. The mortgage is \$18,000.
- Making everything work and developing the plan will require a lot of work and involvement from the congregation.

III. Questions

- Are the proposed budget numbers factoring in the "partnering" opportunities? The answer is no.
- Are there more details of the budget available to review? Yes, David Otts or Sharon Helms has a more detailed budget with all the numbers.
- Could the budget numbers be made available on the web site. Yes.
- When Elmer leaves, can we use a cleaning crew of Trinity members? That could be one way to handle it.
- Do the new fundraisers include the Golf outing and Lambeau? No.
- How can I sign up to help? Talk with Chuck Dorn after the meeting. Talk with Jean Haese after the meeting. Trinity needs the help of everyone.
- When is the next "partnership" meeting. 7pm at Our Redeemer - Menasha
- Do you have any suggestions for the web page? If you do please let David Otts know.
- Is there a "wish list"/ "gift list" for Trinity's special needs. A list will be developed.

IV. Motion to pass the budget was made by Brooks Dodd, seconded by Lou Schoepel. The motion was passed. The meeting was then adjourned.
