## TRINITY COUNCIL MINUTES FROM AUGUST 18, 2009

**In Attendance:** Jean Haese, Jeff Dorow, Tom Scheuerman, Pastor Kurt, Pastor Mary Beth, Chuck Dorn, David Otts, Jann Seidl

**Secretary's Report** - July minutes passed.

**Financial Report** - Sandy LeMoine will finalize the golf outing finances. Trinity continues to operate with a deficit. After further review, the council will communicate to the congregation on how best to proceed.

**Property Committee** - The key to the drop box is missing. Chuck to replace if not found. Review and summary of the cleaning service proposal recommends Moore Clean. Motion to hire Moore Clean was made by Jean Haese and seconded by Terry Howe. The motion passed. Mutual Ministry Team will now decide on how to fill the chores not covered by Moore Clean.

**New Business** -

Discussion of the Grace, Trinity, Zion Visioning Proposal by the Allen-Olson Consulting Firm. This facilitated discussion is designed to achieve the following objectives:

- To share the strengths and weaknesses of each of the congregations
- To identify the common mission of a potential shared partnership of the three congregations
- To identify a shared vision of how a potential partnership could accomplish the common mission
- To provide opportunities for the three congregations to work and grow together through shared strategic focuses

To accomplish these objectives a strategic planning team (SPT) consisting of four individuals from each congregation would participate in the visioning process. These individuals should be key leaders of each congregation. They should be able to see the "big picture" and be able to effectively communicate the shared vision to the congregations that they represent.

It was recommended by the executive council that we proceed with the proposed visioning process with the knowledge that there may be some costs (split three ways) incurred. The motion was made by Jean Haese and seconded by Terry Howe. The motion passed.

After a lengthy discussion four candidates for planning committee were decided upon. These people will be contacted by Tom Scheuerman to see if they would be willing to commit. There will be a transitional meeting held at Zion, September 1, at 7 pm to start this process.

The GTZ group that is lead by Liz Lokensgard will continue with its primary focus on "fellowship" opportunities with the three churches.

Pastor Kurt ended the meeting with prayer.

**Minutes of the July 23, 2009 Property Committee Meeting**

- 1.** Tonight's meeting was opened in the Fireside Room at 7:30 P.M. Sandy Le Moine read from The Word in Season and from Psalm 125.
- 2.** Bassett Engineering has asked for a testimonial letter that they could include in their promotional material. Kris will review wording for a possible letter.
- 3.** Ron Williams made a sign that he and Chuck Dorn mounted above the West entrance. Our thanks to Ron for his continuing work on church projects.
- 4.** Chuck will call Hanson's Plumbing to expedite the overdue cost estimate from them on replacing controls on flushing urinals.
- 5.** Sandy LeMoine led a follow-up discussion on the providing for personnel to take over the various duties and responsibilities of our custodian. In addition to the obvious duties of general housekeeping, there are many not so obvious items such as weekly adjusting boiler settings to

anticipate weather changes, security opening and locking up, checking for steam and water leaks in radiator fittings and plumbing, kitchen "oversight", numerous items that come up that cannot always be anticipated. Chuck suggested the consideration of a 3 person committee trained in setting various controls on the boilers and the need for a printed manual on the operation of our heating and air conditioning system. Sandy LeMoine discussed several candidates for the general weekly cleaning and snow removal (excluding the parking lot).

- 6.** WE Energies has a program for cost sharing on boiler replacements but because of Trinity's dire financial straits we are not in a position to consider boiler replacement at this time.
- 7.** Clarence hopes to conduct his experiment on filling cracks in the surface of the parking lot within the next several weeks.
- 8.** Meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
- 9.** Our next meeting will be Thursday, August 27, at 7:30 p.m.

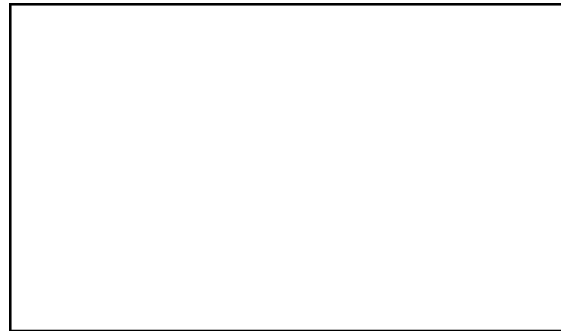
